

- World's first penitentiary
- Eastern State was designed by John Haviland and opened in 1829











Eastern State's Radial Plan Grows



1836: Designed for 450 prisoners



1960: Housing up to 1800 prisoners





1970: Eastern
State closes and prisoners are transferred to SCI Graterford




1980: The City of Philadelphia takes ownership of the site

1985: Eastern State became an abandoned urban jungle







1974-1989: Plans for redevelopment emerge...








Eastern State's Membership Program By The Numbers










Economic Impact (pre-pandemic)










Planned Visitor Center
